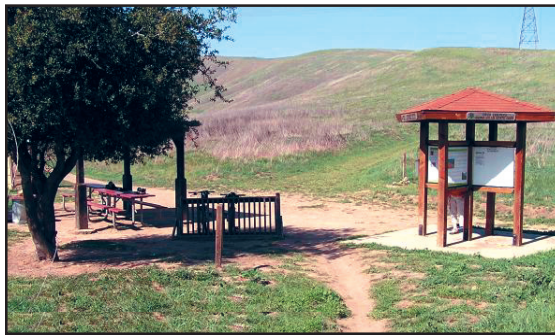
CHINO HILLS STATE PARK

on Sunday, March 18th, 2018



Chino Hills State Park is unique in that it provides refuge for both biodiversity and solitude to the visitors who enjoy their outdoors. At 14,102 acres the park is managed as an open space habitat where all plant and animal life are protected. For safety's sake, stay on designated trails and don't hike or ride alone.

Visitors can camp for a few days or enjoy walking, horseback riding or bicycling over trails that meander along ridge tops and through valleys, woodlands, sage scrub and grasslands. More than 60 miles of trails offer viewing of wildlife and native plants.

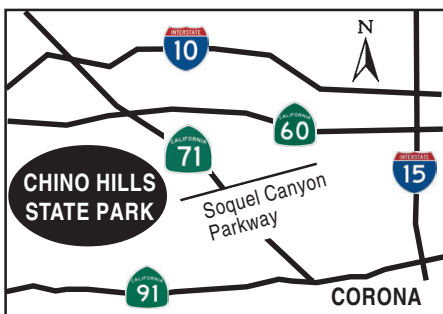


The ride will stage at 9:00am in the parking area at the top of the hill on the right side of the road and depart at **10:00am SHARP**. Your Trail Boss Vicki will lead you on a 2½-3 hour ride at a normal pace on good trails with some moderate hills. At the end of the ride we will have lunch, so don't forget to bring your own drinks and vittles. Water for horses, restrooms and lunch tables will be available. **No Stallions or Dogs on Trail Ride.**

Go 1 mile to **Elinvar Dr.**, turns slightly left and becomes **Sapphire Rd.**, turn right into driveway of the park. **Look for Chino Hills State Park Sign. We will be staging at the top of the hill.**
