

Riverside Recreational Trails Camcover at Cuyamaca Rancho State Park at the Green Valley Campground Friday-Sunday, October 20-22, 2017

Have fun riding and hiking with your fellow RRT friends at Green Valley Horse Camp. Green Valley sits at an elevation of 4,000 feet and has a creek which runs through the middle of the campground. The day use area offers sets of cascades and shallow pools, great for water play on hot days.

The Green Valley Horse Camp has 14 sites available, including 2 sites that are ADA compliant. Each site has 2 corrals for 2 horses, room for one truck and trailer rig and up to 8 people. The camp features a restroom with flush toilets, hot pay showers, water and picnic tables. The Equestrian Camp is located conveniently close to several Park Riding Trails. Both the Monument Trail and the Arroyo Seco Fire Road can be accessed from this location.

We will have a group ride on Saturday, leaving at 10:00am. The ride should be from 3-4 hours. If anyone can't do a 4 hour ride don't worry, we can change the route as needed to make all the riders happy with the length of a ride they can handle. The loop I have in mind has a slight climb up to start with pretty views.

If you would like to come for the day and join us for the Saturday group ride, you will have to park at the Sweetwater Parking Area. It is located just north of the Green Valley Camp inside Cuyamaca Rancho Park. This is a huge parking area with lots of room for your truck and trailer. There are no facilities and they ask that you clean up any horse manure. The lot is open from sunrise to sunset.

To reserve a site you can call 1-800-444-7275 or go on-line at www.reserveamerica.com. It costs about \$35.00 per night plus fees. Reservations can be made at anytime.

Campsites are limited so get your reservation in as soon as possible.

DIRECTIONS:

From Norco go SOUTH on I-15 Fwy. to Hwy. 79, go South through Julian. Follow Hwy. 79 -South past Cuyamaca Lake and Las Vaqueros Group Camp to Green Valley Horse Camp. From Julian to Green Valley it is about 15 miles. Turn left into the Horse Camp.

The other way to go is... SOUTH on I-15 Fwy. to I-8 Fwy., go East to Hwy. 79 -North. It is about 7 miles from I-8 Fwy. to Green Valley Campground. After you stop at the Kiosk you will stay to your RIGHT and make the 1st RIGHT turn into Green Valley Horse Camp. Look for your campsite numbers on the posts.
